## IDENTIFICATION

Each individual that is applying must have one form of identification.

### Examples Include:

- Medicaid, SNAP, or TANF letter
- Drivers license
- Social Security Card
- Picture ID (Official School/employee)
- Military ID
- Immigration Records
- Immunization Record
- Foster placement letter
- Birth Certificate
- Crib card, hospital discharge papers or hospital I.D. bracelet

## INCOME

Bring ALL documents that apply to each household member.

### Examples Include:

- Current Medicaid, SNAP, or TANF letter
- Paycheck stubs for last 30 calendar days (Tax return needed with overtime pay)
- Social security benefits statement
- Tax return IRS 1040
- Unemployment statement
- Child support proof
- Worker's compensation statement
- Retirement income statement
- Signed and dated letter from any person or social service providing income that includes your name, the amount, and type of support given

## PRESENCE

Each individual that is applying for WIC must be present.

## RESIDENCE

Proof of where you live with the entire address listed.

### Examples Include:

- Medicaid, SNAP, or TANF letter
- Utility or credit card bill
- Foster placement letter
- Business letter
- Rent receipts, agreement, or letter
- Immigration Records
- Letter from homeless shelter
- Signed letter from the person you live with stating their name, address, & phone number AND a utility or credit card bill from the person who signed the letter

## DATE OF BIRTH

Date of birth of EACH household member.

A social security number for everyone in the household and immunization records for infants & children,
