40th Traffic Fatality of the Year

7/17/2022

Date: July 15, 2022 at approximately 5:15 p.m.

Location: I-10 East at Lee Trevino

Vehicle 1: 2017 Hyundai Elantra

Vehicle 2: 2018 Dodge Challenger

Vehicle 3: 2001 BMW R11 motorcycle

Driver: 67 -year old Stephen Hoeller of Horizon, TX

Vehicle 4: 2022 Nissan Rogue

Vehicle 5: 2022 Volvo truck-tractor / trailer

El Paso, Texas — Special Traffic Investigation officers responded to I-10 East at Lee Trevino to investigate a fatal traffic collision. A 2018 Dodge Charger, a 2017 Hyundai Elantra, a 2022 Nissan Rogue, and a 2001 BMW motorcycle were traveling east on the left lane when a chain reaction crash occurred.

As traffic became congested, the 2018 Dodge Charger, came to an abrupt stop and was rear-ended by the Hyundai Elantra. The BMW motorcycle rear-ended the Nissan Rogue resulting in the motorcyclist being thrown into the next lane where he was run over by the tractor-trailer. The motorcyclist, Stephen Hoeller was transported to an area hospital where he was pronounced deceased.

This is the 40th traffic fatality of year compared to 34 at this time last year.
